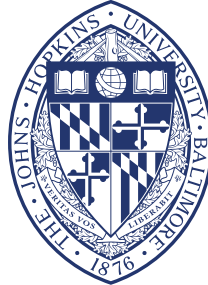

## Our Legacy

For 75 years, students have come to the Johns Hopkins University School of Advanced International Studies (SAIS) to build their professional networks, learn from renowned faculty, train with policy practitioners, and gain hands-on work experience.

The school was founded in 1943 by Paul H. Nitze and Christian Herter, who sought new methods of preparing men and women to cope with the international responsibilities that would be thrust upon the United States following the end of World War II. Scholars and professionals were assembled to teach an academic curriculum emphasizing international relations theory, international economics, and foreign languages. That education, combined with skills training and experiential learning, would prepare students for impact-oriented work in policy and other sectors. In 1955, a campus in Bologna, Italy was established, and in 1986 the school initiated one of the first Western university programs in the People's Republic of China in Nanjing.

Today, guided by the vision of its founders, the school's cadre of expert faculty prepares students for exciting careers across sectors and around the world. With a global alumni network of more than 20,000 graduates, you can be sure to find our alumni taking action all over the world. ## Zeid Ra'ad Al Hussein



Zeid Ra'ad Al Hussein is the former UN High Commissioner for Human Rights (2014–2018). Recognized as a leading and outspoken defender and promoter of universal human rights, he was awarded the Stockholm Human Rights Award in 2015 and the Human Rights Tulip prize in 2018. With a professional background as a practitioner, he represented his country, Jordan, as a senior diplomat—his knowledge is steeped in the global security environment. Immediately prior to his nomination as UN human rights chief, he served as president of the UN Security Council (2014). He was elected the first president of the governing body of the International Criminal Court, guiding the court's growth in its first three years (2002–2005). He chaired some of the most complex legal negotiations associated with the court's statute, in particular those relating to the elements of crimes and the crime of aggression (the “supreme international crime”). He also contributed to the international community's efforts at countering the threat of nuclear materials being trafficked and then used maliciously by terrorists (2010–2014). At the UN, he led efforts to eliminate sexual exploitation and abuse in UN peacekeeping (2004–2007). He twice served as Jordan's ambassador to the United Nations (in New York) and once as Jordan's ambassador to the United States (2007–2010). He also represented Jordan twice before the International Court of Justice. From 1994 to 1996, he was a UN civilian peacekeeper with the United Nations Protection Force. He holds degrees from Johns Hopkins and Cambridge universities and is an Honorary Fellow of Christ's College at Cambridge. In 2019, he was appointed a member of The Elders, an independent group of global leaders working for peace, justice and human rights, founded by Nelson Mandela. He is the distinguished global leader-in-residence at Perry World House at the University of Pennsylvania.
