Fardella previously acted as a Research Scholar at the Machiavelli Center for Cold War Studies, member of the Academic Committee at Pangoal Institution in Beijing and Fellow of the Science & Technology China Program of the European Commission. His fields of interests are: the history of Chinese foreign policy; China relations with the EU, the Middle East and Italy from the Cold War to the present.
