Johannes has authored and co-authored research articles for, among others, the yearbook of the German Council on Foreign Relations, *Internationale Politik* and the *European Journal of Futures Research*. He received a master's degree with distinction in political science and economics as well as a certificate in modern Chinese language from the University of Trier. From 2009 to 2011 he was a PhD fellow with the Society and Technology Research Group in Berlin, the Daimler AG's foresight division.
