Erik Jones is Professor of European Studies and International Political Economy, and Director of European and Eurasian Studies at the Johns Hopkins School of Advanced International Studies (SAIS). He is also a Senior Research Associate at the Istituto per gli Studi di Politica Internazionale (ISPI) in Milan. Professor Jones is author of *The Politics of Economic and Monetary Union* (2002), *Economic Adjustment and Political Transformation in Small States* (2008), *Weary Policeman: American Power in an Age of Austerity* (2012, with Dana H. Allin), and *The Year the European Crisis Ended* (2014). He is editor or co-editor of a number of books and special issues of journals on topics related to European politics and political economy including *The Oxford Handbook of the European Union* (2012) and *The Oxford Handbook of Italian Politics* (2015). Professor Jones is co-editor of *Government & Opposition* and a contributing editor of *Survival*. His commentary has appeared in numerous outlets including the *Financial Times*, the *New York Times*, and other major newspapers and magazines across Europe and North America. A US citizen, Professor Jones has lived in Europe since the late 1980s.
