MAGP Overview

The Master of Arts in Global Policy (MAGP) is a one year, cohort-based executive-style MA designed for full-time working professionals interested in advancing in their careers or pivoting to a new field. Classes meet in person every two weeks on a Friday (full day) and Saturday (half day) schedule. The curriculum also features several multiday experiential learning residencies, including a one-week international capstone research trip.

Degree snapshot:

- 9 core courses highlighting SAIS's global policy strengths
- 3 elective regional/functional courses (determined each year based on cohort preferences)
- 2 semester-long, self-paced online application seminars designed to prepare students for the capstone research project
- 4 multiday experiential learning residencies (3 domestic, 1 international)
- 1 capstone research project
- 40 credits total

- Classes meet in person every two weeks on a Friday/Saturday schedule, during three class slots:
 - Friday morning: 8:30am-12:15pmFriday afternoon: 1:15pm 5:00pm
 - ➤ Saturday morning: 9:30am 1:15pm
 - Saturday afternoon: reserved for make-up classes
- MAGP provides/covers:
 - required textbooks
 - catered breakfast and lunch on class days
 - most residency-related travel expenses (except Global Residency international airfare)
- Tuition breakdown: Fall & Intersession (19 credits); Spring & Summer (21 credits)
- SAIS Commencement: all students who have completed their pre-capstone credit requirements are eligible to participate in the SAIS-wide commencement in May
