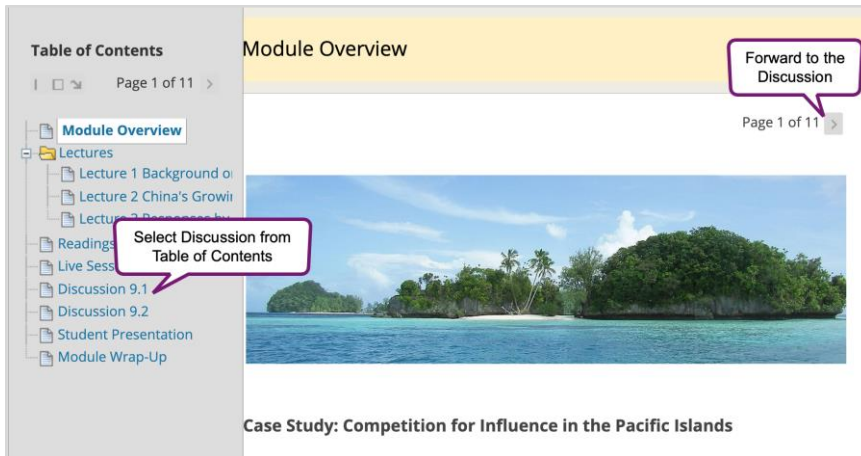


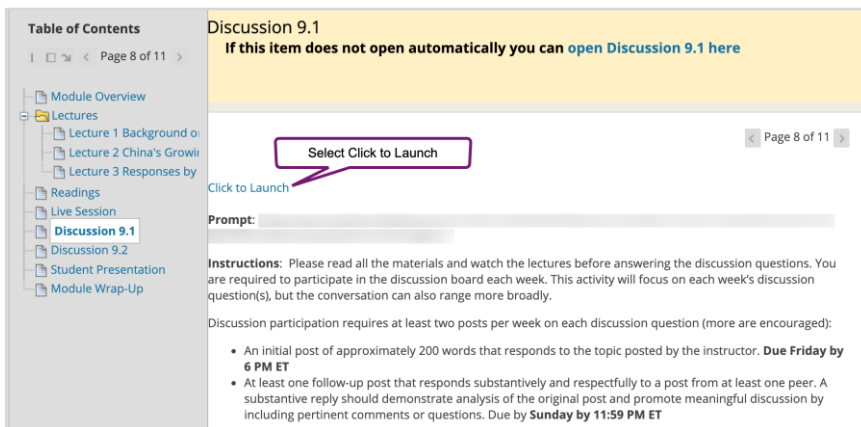
## Blackboard Discussion Forums

Throughout your course, you will use the Blackboard Discussion Forums to communicate with your colleagues and to complete course assignments.

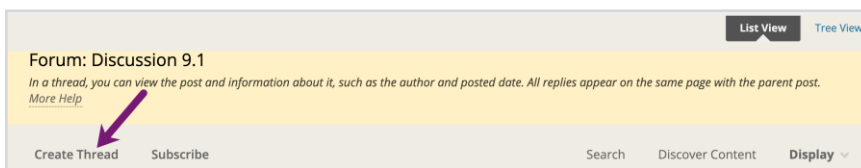
1. Access the specific discussion forum within the course module. You can navigate to the discussion forum using the Table of Contents menu, or by selecting the forward button until you arrive at the module discussion forum.



2. Review the instructions, prompt, and grading criteria.
3. Select **Click to Launch**.



4. Select **Create Thread**.



5. Enter a subject line.
6. Compose your post in the text editor.

7. Select **Submit** to post to the forum.
